Texas wines have come a long way in the past few years and we are glad to help promote this industry and what it has done for the state and local areas.

This special event will take place during the 22<sup>nd</sup> annual Dripping Springs Founders Day Festival. Come enjoy a glass of wine or sampling of a local beer with your friends at our "dance hall" across the street from Rippy's Feed on Mercer Street, sponsored by Carter Investments. The first 100 registered participants will receive a free wine tasting glass at the event. We highly recommend advanced registration for the event, and you may pick up your tickets at City Hall up to a week in advance or at "will call" which will be located at the entrance.



The event proceeds will go towards improvements at Harrison Ranch Park, located on Ranch Road 12 across from Dripping Springs Elementary School. The park is being developed into an agricultural themed park with an open air pavilion suited for equestrian and livestock events, a play ground, primitive tent campsites, a crushed granite pedestrian trail, an open play area, equestrian trails, an 18-hole course for disk golf, horseshoe and washer courts and designated picnic areas.

All weekend long, Founders Day Festival-goers will enjoy free live music and entertainment, cook off competitions, tasty BBQ and traditional fair food, as well as a maze of arts, crafts and business vendors. For the young and young at heart, take pleasure in the pony rides, the fifth largest washer pitching tournament in the country and of course, the Mighty Thomas Carnival.
